2021 SCHOLARSHIPS TENABLE IN IRELAND

Applications are invited from suitable qualified persons for scholarships offered by the Government of Ireland, to pursue Master Programmes tenable in Ireland for the 2021/2022 academic year.

TO BE ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS MUST:

- be a Vincentian National residing in St. Vincent and the Grenadines or the Caribbean;
- have a minimum of three (3) years work experience that is directly relevant to their proposed programme(s) of study (this can include internship);
- have obtained a University degree (Bachelors) with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (4.0 scale) within the last twelve (12) years;
- not hold a master's degree or higher, nor be currently reading for a master's degree, neither be due to start a master's programme in the 2021/2022 academic year.
- be applying to commence a master's programme in Ireland no sooner than August 2022;
- be able to demonstrate the following:
 - a) Leadership abilities and aspirations;
 - b) A commitment to continue to building positive relationships with Ireland;
 - c) A commitment to address climate change and its associated challenges within St. Vincent and the Grenadines.

- be proficient in the English language;
- must not have applied to the Ireland Fellows Programme on more than one (1) previous occasion;
