2022 SCHOLARSHIPS TENABLE IN SWITZERLAND

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for a Master of Advanced Studies in European and International Governance (MEIG Programme) offered by the University of Geneva, Switzerland.

The MEIG Programme combines academic studies and practical training, followed by an internship in an international organization or an in-depth study on a governance-related topic.

The University of Geneva is offering scholarships for excellent candidates who do not have the financial means to cover the cost of the MEIG programme. The scholarship covers mainly tuition fees.

The duration of the programme is 10 months and is particularly aimed at young professionals who already have practical experience and wish to improve their knowledge of European and international governance. The programme starts in **September 2022 and ends in July 2023**.
