SCHOLARSHIP OFFERED BY THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO 2026/2027

The Government of the Kingdom of Morocco is offering scholarships to Vincentian nationals to pursue studies at Moroccan public universities, higher institutes and vocational training centres for Undergraduate or Postgraduate (Master/PhD) level, commencing the 2026/2027 academic year.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should:

- ▣ apply to the University for acceptance;
- ▣ be no more than twenty-three (23) years old for Undergraduate studies;
- ▣ hold a CAPE/Associate Degree in 2025 or 2026 with grade A or B (undergraduate);
- ▣ hold a Bachelor's degree and/or Master's degree (for Master's and PhD respectively).

Applicants must submit:

- ▣ Medical Certificate issued by the public health authority, to attest medical fitness of the candidate and to certify that he/she is vaccinated and is not suffering from any contagious or acute diseases, or carrying a pandemic, including tuberculosis;
- ▣ Copy of birth certificate
- ▣ Certified copy of CSEC Certificate {obtained no later than 2023} (certified by the Accreditation Department);
- ▣ Certified copy of Cape or Associate Degree diploma (1st and 2nd terms)
- ▣ 1st and 2nd year CAPE or Associate Degree transcripts;
- ▣ Copy of Identification Card;
- ▣ Copy passport biodata page;
- ▣ A recent Police Record;
- ▣ Certified copies of Bachelor's or Master's degree certificate (certified by the Accreditation Department) and official grade transcripts;
- ▣ In addition, applicants for doctoral studies must provide their master's dissertation/thesis and doctoral thesis project.
