The deadline for both scholarships is mid of March, 2026, the Embassy welcomes all qualified Vincentian youths seeking bachelor, master or PhD degrees in Taiwan to apply for the Scholarships.

Scope of Scholarship

Entitlements: The total scholarship, including airfare (round-trip), housing, tuition, credit fees, insurance, textbook costs and a monthly allowance will be provided by the Taiwan I CDF to each student within his/her given award period. The scholarship is itemized as follows:

- **Airfare:** The Taiwan I CDF shall arrange your most-direct flights to and from Taiwan with Economy Class tickets. Every airline has its own carry-on and check-in luggage policy, including for weight limits and transporting pets. Applicants have been advised to check with the airlines for details before departure.
- **Housing:** All students must reside in the student dormitories.
- **Tuition fee:** The Taiwan I CDF will cover the tuition fee as required by the student's university.
- **Credit fees:** Credit fees vary with the number of credits registered. Credit fees will also be covered as required by the student's university.

Scope of Scholarship

- Insurance: While in Taiwan, in addition to the mandatory student safety insurance set by the Ministry of Education, each student must be insured for accidental and necessary medical coverage. Insurance fees will be covered for the entire duration of the program.
- Book costs: Purchasing textbooks as required by the instructors shall be subject to the approval of the director of the student's institute
- Allowance:
 1. Bachelor's Program: Each student shall receive NT\$15,000 per month during the period of the program as allowance for food and miscellaneous living expenses. The sum will be deposited monthly into the student's local bank account.
 2. Master's Program: Each student shall receive NT\$18,000 per month during the period of the program as allowance for food and miscellaneous living expenses. The sum will be deposited monthly into the student's local bank account.
 3. Ph. D. Program: Each student shall receive NT\$20,000 per month during the period of the program as allowance for food and miscellaneous living expenses. The sum will be deposited monthly into the student's local bank account.
