- Providing technical assistance and advising to the Ministry
- Collaborating with relevant government entities on the implementation of strategies for urban planning
- Assisting in the preparation, updating and monitoring of development plans, programmes and strategies for the urban areas
- Other duties and responsibilities assigned by the Permanent Secretary in keeping with the position of the Urban Planner
