#### **QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCES**

- Admission to practice as an Attorney-at-Law;
- Extensive experience in legislative drafting and legal advisory work; and
- Sound knowledge of the Constitution and laws of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines.

#### **DUTIES**

The duties of the officer appointed to the post will include the following:

- preparing and draft legislation for the Government;
- advising on legislative proposals and constitutional matters;
- reviewing draft legislation for legal sufficiency and consistency;
- supervising and mentor Parliamentary Counsel and drafting staff;
- liaising with Ministries, Departments and statutory bodies regarding legislative instructions;
- assisting in the modernization and revision of the laws of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines;
- providing legal support in relation to parliamentary procedures and legislative matters; and
- Undertaking related duties assigned by the Attorney General or Solicitor General.
