- Qualification to practice law in St. Vincent and the Grenadines.
- Minimum of three (3) years relevant experience as a practicing lawyer.

### DUTIES

- **Advising government and law enforcement agencies on behalf of the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions-National Prosecution Service.**
- **Other duties as assigned by the Director of Public Prosecutions.**
