- Working experience in the Field of Mechanical Engineering, in Ventilation, Air Conditioning and Plumbing in design, will be an asset;
- Supervision of Mechanical installation works and testing;

- Knowledge of relevant software, AutoCAD, Revit MEP, CHVAC
