- Legal Education Certificate or equivalent recognized qualification to practice law in St. Vincent and the Grenadines.
- A minimum of five (5) years relevant experience practicing law.

DUTIES

The duties of the officer appointed to the post will include the following:

- **At the direction of the Director of Public Prosecution or any delegated officer to prosecute matters in any Magistrate Court, High Court or at the Court of Appeal.**
- **Assisting in Administrative Management of the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions-National Prosecution Service.**
- **Supervising Junior Crown Counsels.**
- **Advising government and law enforcement agencies on behalf of the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions-National Prosecution Service.**
- **Other duties as assigned by the Director of Public Prosecutions.**
