Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons to fill a post of **Chief Pharmacist** at the Ministry of Health, Wellness, Environmental Health and Energy.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

Applicants should possess the following:

- Minimum of a Bachelors in Pharmacy or related field
- Post graduate Pharmacy Administration, or General Management or public administration.
- A minimum of five years in experience in a senior pharmaceutical position.
- A high level of professional competence, responsibility and accountability.

DUTIES

The duties of the post include:

- Responsibility and accountability for all professional and managerial activities associated with the provision, management and development of pharmacy service and strategic development of medicines management initiatives.
- Monitoring existing pharmacies and pharmacist for effective operation.
- Monitoring the functions of the Central Medical Stores and consult with drug representatives for supplies and information on new drugs.
- Monitoring the purchasing programs to ensure no significant inventory build up, shortage and waste.
- Chairperson of the St. Vincent and the Grenadines Pharmacy Council.
- Overall supervision and deployment of Pharmaceutical Staff.
- Preparing the annual co-operate plan for the Pharmaceutical Services.
- Monitoring drug usage patterns and service levels at all health facility.
